



### **BIOSKETCH**

Enrique O'Connor is currently Full Professor at the Department of Biochemistry and Molecular Biology of the University of Valencia and director of the Laboratory of Cytomics, a joint Research Unit of the University of Valencia and the Principe Felipe Research Center. Since 1983 he has been mostly involved in the development and application of cytoxic functional assays to predictive toxicology and to translational studies of immune cells and platelets. He dedicates a substantial activity to education in Cytometry and Cytomics, including the organization of ESCCA international Summer Schools. He has been founding member and twice president of the Iberian Society for Cytometry (SIC), an ESCCA-affiliated society. He has been involved in services to ESCCA since 2009, in the Executive Board and the Education and Accreditation Committee, as well as ESCCA auditor. He has been responsible for the organization of two ESCCA Euroconferences in Valencia (2010, 2018). He participates actively in the Editorial Board of the journal Cytometry.
