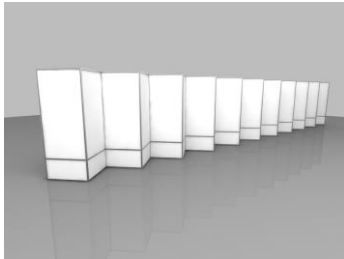


INSTRUCTIONS FOR POSTER PRESENTERS

1. **Poster size:**

Each poster board is 1 meter wide.

The poster should not exceed 1,20 meter high x 0,90 meter wide (A0 poster).



IMPORTANT!!

Your poster should be in PORTRAIT.

Posters in landscape format will not be accepted. They will be removed from the poster boards.

2. **Preparation and printing of your poster**

- The poster titles should be identical to the title of the abstract.
- Please print your poster on regular, or slightly thick paper, or canvas. Heavy materials won't stick well to the poster boards and risk to fall off.
- If you consider having your poster printed locally, please contact (one of) the print company(ies) that will be mentioned on the [Abstract page of the Conference website](#) (information available by 4 September). Please note that the organisers cannot accept any responsibility for the services or quality provided.

3. **Poster board number:**

An overview of your poster (board) number will be sent to you approximately 10 days before the Conference. Please remember your number or print the overview and take it with you, so that you can easily find your poster board.

5. **Poster set-up:**

Posters can be put on the allocated poster board in the Exhibition area on

- Saturday 23 September during Pre-registration from 17.00-19.30 hrs.
 - Sunday 24 September from 08.00 until 11.30 hrs. at the latest
- Fixing materials (velcro) will be available in the poster area.

6. **Display period:**

- All posters will be on display from Sunday 24 September from the lunch break, until Wednesday 27 September up to and including the lunch break.
- You are kindly requested to be present by their posters for discussion with delegates during the morning coffee breaks, and second half of the lunch breaks.

7. **Poster dismantling:**

Posters should remain on the poster boards until the end of the Conference.

Posters should be removed on Wednesday 27 September between 14.00 - 17.30 hrs.

The organisation will not be responsible for posters that are not removed on time ; they will be discarded after the Conference.
